In the case of successful passing of the seminar and the exam, the participants of this seminar have a chance to be chosen as official judges for the 2nd Youth KWU Kyokushin European Championship in Berlin 2019. Candidates for judging will pay all their expenses themselves.

Participation: Representatives of national federations with calling in all interested groups of Kyokushin in a particular country at the age from 8 to 11 years and up to 4 fighters from each country in each weight category.

All participants must submit:

- a medical health certificate with doctor's permission for participation, which is not older than 3 months,
- birth certificate or passport + budo passport,
- valid insurance license or insurance card (original) ,
- declaration of consent from a parent.



Start fee: 30 € for each fighter (the starting contribution includes a gift package to the participant, a lunch package in the days of a tournament, accommodation of official judges in days of holding of the 2nd Youth Kyokushin-kan European Championship).

Entrance: free

Rules: This tournament will be held basing by KWU rules, which you can find at the official KWU website - <http://www.kwunion.com/documents/>

Age and weight categories

Age category (discipline)	Weight category
boys (8 -9 full years, kumite)	25, 30, 35, 40, 45, 45+
girls (8 -9 full years, kumite)	30, 35, 40, 40+
boys (10-11 full years, kumite)	30, 35, 40, 45, 50, 50+
girls (10-11 full years, kumite)	35, 40, 45, 45+

Attention, the organizers reserve the right to merge categories, subject to insufficient applications in one or more categories!

The age of the fighters is determined on the day of passing the credentials committee, which is May 17, 2019.

Timing of bouts:

Age category "boys/ girls" (8-9 years)

Preliminary fights: 1,5 minutes + 1 minute

Semifinals - and final fights: 2 minutes + 1 minute + weight check (difference 2,5 kg. and more) + 1 minute

Age category "boys/ girls" (10-11 years)

Preliminary fights: 2 minutes + 1 minute

Semifinals - and final fights: 2 minutes + 1,5 minute + weight check (difference 2,5 kg. and more) + 1 minute



Protection equipment:

Each fighter, allowed to participate in competitions, must have:

- white karategi and a belt, representing fighter's qualification;
- individual groin shell: for boys - mandatory, for girls - voluntary;
- protectors for shin and insteps - mandatory;
- knee pads, elbow pads - voluntary;
- hand mittens - mandatory;
- headgear - mandatory for all;
- chest protector of a standard type - for girls;
- gum shield (oral cavity protector), white color - voluntary.
If there are brackets on teeth, gum shield is mandatory.

All protection items must have a mark of KWU or correspond to the requirements of KWU.

All participants will have possibility to purchase protection items before the credentials commission.

ATTENTION! All protection items must be individual; each fighter must have his own!

Financial conditions

The organizer will pay the following charges:

- lunch for fighters on the both days of the championship – May 18-19, 2019
- lunch for official judges on May 17-19, 2019
- accommodation of official judges, who are chosen for judging at the 2nd Youth European Championship KWU 2019, May 17-20, 2019 in twin rooms in a accredited hotel (breakfast included)
- transfer for accredited judges: hotel - arena - hotel on the days of the championship.

Accredited judges and competitors on their own will cover all the other expenses.

The organizer will not cover any expenses of other groups of participants of this tournament.

2. To reserve hotel in Berlin and to receive confirmation in writing. (In case of booking of our hotel – to transfer money of 10% of all amount or to give the data of VISA CARD for payment confirmation)



3. Flight tickets, train etc.
4. The certified permissions from parents for taking of children abroad.
5. Certificate from the place of work with the information about the salary.
6. To receive from organizers:
 - a) Invitation to the entire team.
 - b) Provision of the Youth European Championship – the original.
 - c) The statement from our "Verayn's Register".
 - d) A reservation of hotel with a seal – the original.
 - e) The statement from Spotramt – about the venue of the championship.
 - f) The passport copy of the president, vice-president and accountant of the inviting organization – Alexey Demanov, Andrey Perminov and Irina Demanov.

Free visas can be issued ONLY for participants, coaches and the doctor of one team. All accompanying persons, most likely, will have to pay for their visas in embassies. Therefore, it is very important to specify in what status they arrive.

You will also need to book an appointment in the nearest Consulate of Germany. As far as we are concerned, only one person, who will be stated as responsible person, can come to this appointment. You will also have to fill in the questionnaire for Visa (from the Consulate website) and to glue the photos there.
